## **Enable Flash Player for Google Chrome**

To enable Flash Player for Google Chrome, click the **Blocked Flash** icon on the right corner of the address bar then click the **Manage** button.



Toggle on the button next to **Block sites from running Flash**. This way Chrome will ask first before blocking flash content.
