

Perelberg Award Criteria

The Perelberg Award – an annual award for ‘Exemplary Scotch Spirit’ is alternately granted one year to a current student or to one who left the previous year, and the next to an Old Scotch Collegian. This year the award will be made to an Old Boy who has demonstrated ‘Exemplary Scotch Spirit’.

The award is made in memory of a former student of Scotch, Ashley Perelberg, a member of the Class of '92, who died in 1993 from a heart attack while training during his first year at university. Ashley had been very well known at Scotch for his full and enthusiastic involvement in many aspects of the school – he exemplified what we often refer to as the ‘Scotch Spirit’:

- striving for personal excellence while recognising and serving the needs of others
- applying high personal standards
- showing compassion for those not able to reach those same standards
