Dear Fellow Member,

There was a positive review of the club events for 2022 at the committee meeting held on 8th February with the attendance at functions indicative of good support from members. Clearly, our most popular functions remain the start of year Brunch @ Kooyong and the Christmas Cocktail Party held at Scotch.

The financial report for 2022 showed a balance of \$7,640. It is not our wish to grow this balance but rather to ensure funds are used to subsidise attendance at our functions to the benefit of as many members as possible. Members who attended all 4 events in 2022 received a subsidy of \$85 while those who attended last year's brunch and cocktail party received a subsidy of \$53. We were pleased to note that last year's operations were run at a small deficit which is in line with our aim to reduce our balance to around \$5,000 over the next 3 to 4 years. Since 2017 a grant from the annual distribution of earnings of the John Bell Armstrong and Sutherland Armstrong Perpetual Fund has been allocated to the club by the Scotch College Foundation and we have recently received notification that a grant of \$3,000 has been allocated for 2023. The club is most grateful for this support for its purposes.
