Dear Fellow Member,

Our committee met on Monday 5 February to review the operation of the club during 2023 and to make plans for 2024. There is no doubting the collegiality evident at club events with attendances remaining very strong and membership having reached 200.

Our club exists as part of the Scotch Family under the auspices of OSCA and recently, OSCA has approached all clubs to sign a 'Clubs Charter' that seeks to give an appropriate framework to the operation of all OSCA clubs. Following agreement at our committee meeting, I have signed the Charter on behalf of our club.

The financial report for 2023 showed a balance of \$7,113 with the club's operations running at a small deficit in line with our aim to reduce our balance to around \$5,000 over the next few years. We are most grateful for the strong and on-going support of the School, The Scotch College Foundation and OSCA. In 2023 The Foundation provided a grant of \$3,000 from the John Bell Armstrong and Sutherland Armstrong Perpetual Fund and OSCA granted a payment of \$500 towards the costs associated with our end of year function. We have recently received letters indicating that these grants will be maintained in 2024.

We continue to send birthday cards to members as they reach milestone birthdays. Some of these members live interstate and some have not been able to get to club functions for some time. We have received some delightful communications from these members who continue to receive newsletters and follow the events of the club. I thank our secretary, Hugh Wilson, who coordinates the sending of these cards.
